- Show set up begins at 7:30AM and must be completed by 9:00AM.
- Tent locations are assigned by GMSP Art Team.
- Artists must supply own tents, tables, chairs, etc. and can share a space.
- Proceeds of all sales remain with the artist.
- Food and beverages are available within short walk at several local businesses.

Most artists use credit card service such as Square or Paypal. Credit card sales can also be made through GMSP and will be available to vendors for a processing fee. Contact GMSP if interested.

Goffstown Main Street Program **Promotion Policies for Uncommon Art Vendors 2020**

**--ALL artworks must represent original work of the registered artist --
not produced from a kit. Artists new to outdoor shows are especially encouraged to apply.**

Here's what you need to know in advance:

- 1. Events are held rain or shine, unless there is a safety issue.** We suggest you be prepared for inclement weather. If we need to cancel the event for safety reasons or if it looks like a complete washout, we will contact you as soon as that decision is made—via Uncommon Art Facebook Page, cell phone or other means to be determined.
- 2. Artists are responsible to provide ALL setup equipment and supplies.**
- 3. Please be ready no later than 9 AM and do not start to tear down until 3 PM.**
- 4. Once your vehicle is unloaded, please immediately remove your vehicle from the area adjacent to the venue to give other artists space to unload .**
- 5. After unloading please move your vehicle** to the Municipal parking lot on School Street (next to Common), the Town Hall parking lot (off Main St and Church St) or Maple Avenue Elementary School (off Elm Street). **It's very important to keep the closest parking spots available for show customers and area businesses.**
- 6. If you are using a popup tent of any kind, you must also bring at least four--30 lb weights to anchor the corners . This will help ensure that no tent collapses causing injury or damage to art work. STAKES ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
- 7. Please take your trash home at the end of the day.** Main Street will empty trash from the general public, but artists are asked to take trash you generate.
- 8. The Art Team reserves the right to assign booth spaces.** On the day of the event, please check at the Main Street booth/office **BEFORE** you set up to ensure you have correctly identified your spot, and that nothing has changed at the last minute. **The decision of the Art Team on booth placement is final.**
- 9. Please do not ask to be moved unless there is an issue of safety.** Art Team may ask you to move if an unforeseen problem arises, (i.e., vendor no-show, or we have a space to fill).
- 10. Please have your setup completed at the advertised start time of the event, and plan to remain until the advertised end time before taking down your booth.** This keeps our guests engaged throughout the event, and keeps the show looking full and active. Please plan to be at your booth for the entire show. Ask nearby artist to cover bathroom breaks.

Thank you for abiding by these policies. We hope you have a successful show!

Please remember we host these events to bring people to the Downtown as well as to promote local artists. The events serve the purpose of building a stronger community as well as promoting the Downtown as a good place to shop, eat, live, or conduct business. Our primary goal is the economic revitalization of the Downtown, and we are glad to have you as partners. Above all, we want our events to be fun for EVERYONE—guests, partners, and GMSP teams.

Hello Uncommon Art Artists 2020!

Every year the Goffstown Main Street Art Team creates a way to encourage our visitors and fans to stop each artist's booth.

The popular '**Uncommon Bling**' necklace is back for 2020!

Here's how it works:

1. Visitors pick up a clear bag at the Main Street Program Booth at 7 Main Street. Inside is a necklace with barrel clasp—handmade by our very own artist *Nina Duval*. Be sure your **Bling** has a loop or hole or way to fit the 5mm thick cord/necklace.
2. Artists make and provide at their booth approx 25-50 **Blings**—that are somehow related to what you do as an art form which could be hung on this necklace—ie. bead, rock, shell, fabric, metal, candy, paper, mini photo, wood etc. Traditional pendant or **Uncommon**—your choice! Put your **Bling** in a clear bag with a business card so fans can contact you after the show!
3. Visitors will stop by booths to collect **Bling** and you will use this opportunity to explain your art and get their contact info!
4. On show day, you will pick up Info Packet at the Main Street booth. Hang the 'Bling' sign tbd on your booth to signify you are participating in '**Uncommon Bling**' 2020 Project! **Good luck!**
